ANATOLII GRYTSENKO – OUTSTANDING SCIENTIST AND TEACHER (To the 70th anniversary of the scientist)



Anatoly Gritsenko is a well-known scientist in the field of environmental protection in Ukraine and abroad, an academician of the Ukrainian Ecological Academy of Sciences, honored worker of science and technology of Ukraine.

Born on August 12, 1949 in with. Rakitnoe, Novovodolazhsky district, Kharkov region.

After studying at the Kharkov Mechanics and Technology College and serving in the Soviet Army in 1970. He entered the Kharkov Order of Lenin Polytechnic Institute. IN AND.

Lenin - a leading institution of higher education of a scientific and technical profile at the Faculty of Power Engineering, which he graduated with honors in 1976

Already at that time, in addition to professional ones, his organizational abilities were clearly manifested. After several years of working in engineering positions at the factory of tractor self-propelled chassis, for 5 years he successfully heads the trade union committee of the plant.

Since 1986 A. Gritsenko decides to devote his knowledge, experience, scientific and technical potential and organizational abilities to serving one of the noble goals - the protection of the environment.

For 10 years, A. Gritsenko – Deputy and Head of the Kharkiv Regional Inspectorate for Nature Protection, First Deputy Head of the State Administration for Environmental Protection of the Kharkiv Region.

In 1991 A. Gritsenko successfully defends his thesis and receives the degree of Candidate of Sciences, and in 1994. – Doctors of Sciences. In 1995 He was awarded the academic title of Professor.

In 1996 A. Gritsenko headed the research institution “Ukrainian Research Institute of Ecological Problems”, at that time – the Ukrainian Scientific Center for Water Protection, whose director he still works.

It should be noted that work as a director of the institute was interrupted from 2001 to 2006. During this period, A. Gritsenko served as Deputy State Secretary of the Ministry of Natural Resources of Ukraine and Deputy Minister of Ecology and Natural Resources of Ukraine.

His merits in a high state post are highly appreciated by the state. In 2002 A. Gritsenko awarded the honorary title “Honored Worker of Science and Technology of Ukraine”, in 2004 he was awarded the medal “For Labor and Valor”.

In addition, A. Gritsenko conducts fruitful scientific and pedagogical activities. He was a co-founder and for more than 20 years the head of the first in Ukraine Department of Ecology, formed at a higher educational institution of a technical direction – Kharkov National Automobile and Highway University. In addition, he founded and for many years headed the UNESCO Chair "Environmentally Clean Technologies", which now fruitfully works at the Kharkov National Automobile and Highway University. His experience is embodied in many scientific works, monographs and other printed publications.

Headed A. Gritsenko research institution “Ukrainian Research Institute of Ecological Problems” is one of the leading scientific organizations in the system of environmental protection of Ukraine.

The main goal of the institution's activities is the scientific support of state policy in the field of environmental protection, the use of natural resources, environmental and radiation safety, as well as the fulfillment of Ukraine's international obligations arising from signed conventions, agreements, and treaties.

As a scientist and teacher A. Gritsenko pays great attention to the training of young professionals. Under his leadership, a number of doctoral and master's theses were defended.
