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**SPECIFIC FEATURES OF LANGUAGE TRAINING IN NON-
LANGUAGE HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS OF AUTOMOBILE
AND HIGHWAY ORIENTATION**

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One of the main tasks of higher education is the training of highly qualified professionals with a broad work culture and flexible thinking, as the global problem is that people with technical education «have low communication skills» [1].

International activity as the most important factor in the development of modern technical higher education institutions for its staff and students implies the organization of research and educational activities in the international space, which requires active language proficiency in one or more foreign languages. According to a foreign researcher, «The global high-tech industry is characterized by high competition, innovation and widespread use of English» [3].

The task of modern technical higher education institution is not only to involve foreign specialists in research, pedagogical activities and exchange of experience, but first of all – to gain key positions in the world of science and education. Despite the fact that, according to European scholars, the level of knowledge of English among modern youth is quite high [2], it is not always sufficiently focused on achieving professional goals. The process of development of European education associated with the signing of the Bologna Agreement has affected all higher

education institutions in the European region, so it has given rise to new approaches of teaching a foreign language.

The level of international cooperation for technical higher education institution has changed, and at the present stage it is a set of complex tasks directly related to the skills of foreign language intercultural communication, ability to work in a team, personal and professional qualities that determine the level of research and pedagogical activities that can be implemented under the condition of a high level of development of foreign language communicative competence in the professional sphere of communication. To achieve these goals we have to use all possible methods, including teamwork of teachers.

In its work, the teaching staff of Kharkiv National Automobile and Highway University (KhNAHU) takes into account the rich experience of training specialists in the automotive industry, keeping in mind new opportunities associated with changes in educational and sociocultural context of foreign languages learning in general: increasing interest in foreign languages learning, in particular English. KhNAHU successfully solves one of the most important tasks of modern professional training of future specialists in the field of science, engineering and technology – ensuring the quality of language education through comprehensive language training focused on solving the problems of the internal environment of technical higher education institution (the dominance of the monolingual community, the average starting level of junior students in the development of communicative foreign language competence), as well as it meets the challenges of modern socio-economic development of society in the context of globalization.

The language environment of technical higher education institution will allow students and teachers in the future to decide independently on the formation of a creative team of researchers with international participation, to summarize research results in scientific publications in a foreign language and, consequently, to participate in international competitions and grants, in other words, to receive international recognition.

In general, to achieve the above targets at the level of language training,

university staff and students must: carry out oral and written communication in a foreign language (business correspondence, oral negotiations, written scientific and business documentation), participate in international activities (cooperate with foreign colleagues; use a foreign language in teaching and research activities), and then «a unique combination of engineering and language competence is formed», and «A graduate of technical higher education institution as a carrier of this combination is in demand in the domestic labor market» [4].

These tasks are solved by the system of language training of employees and students of KhNAHU.
